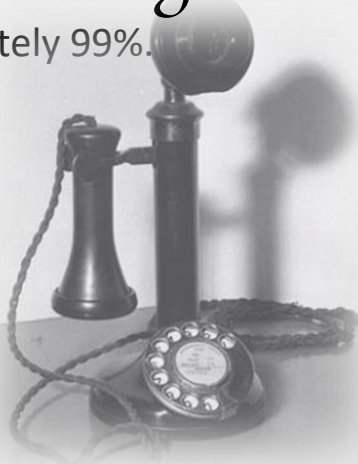


Declaration of Expectations
